## **Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase**

A tax rate of \$.1339 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of the Southwest Texas Junior College District.

PROPOSED TAX RATE \$ 0.133900 per \$100

NO-NEW-REVENUE TAX RATE \$ 0.128560 per \$100

VOTER-APPROVAL TAX RATE \$ 0.139137 per \$100

The no-new-revenue tax rate for the 2022 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for the Southwest Texas Junior College District from the same properties in both the 2021 tax year and the 2022 tax year.

The voter-approval rate is the highest tax rate that the Southwest Texas Junior College District may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. That means that Southwest Texas Junior College District is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2022 tax year.

A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED TAX RATE WILL BE HELD ON September 8, 2022 at 12:00 noon in the Bluebonnet Room of the Matthews Student Center on the Uvalde Campus of Southwest Texas Junior College.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, Southwest Junior College District is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the Board of Trustees Administrator, Nita Reed, of the Southwest Texas Junior College District at her office or by attending the public hearing mentioned above.

YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE TAX RATES MENTIONED ABOVE CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS: Property tax amount = (tax rate) x (taxable value of your property) / 100
