The State of Texas requires that certain supporting documentation accompany a student's request to be reclassified as a resident for tuition and fees purposes.

For a student's residency status to become effective, and tuition changed for the current semester, <u>ALL</u> documents must be received and processed by the census date (12th class day) of the current semester.
